Scope and Main Topics

This new symposium will be organized as a forum for interdisciplinary discussion between scientists from Asian universities, research institutions and companies on chemistry, physics and biology of advanced materials that can serve for improving and developing of chemical engineering and nanotechnology, microelectronics and optics, materials processing, oil production, food, biochemical, pharmaceutical and biomedical technologies that in their turn increase the quality and make human life healthy and comfortable.

2. Synthesis and Properties of Nanomaterials.
3. Chemistry and Physics of Polymers and Biopolymers.
4. Inorganic and Hybrid Organo-Inorganic Materials.
5. Biomimetic and Biorelated Materials.
6. Films, Membranes, Surface Modification and Coatings.
7. Theoretical Approaches and Simulation.
8. Engineering Aspects: Fabrication Techniques, Processing and Characterization.
9. Advanced Materials and Ecology.

PROGRAM

The Symposium program will include about 20-25 invited lectures (30 min), and oral communications (15 min) presented by students and young scientists. It will be opened by a plenary lecture by Prof. Alexei Khokhlov (Moscow State University). The poster session is not planned.

LANGUAGE

English is the official language of the Symposium.

Venue

Vladivostok is geographically close to China, Korean peninsula, and Japan.

The symposium will be in one of halls of the University.

It is equipped with all technical facilities for scientific meetings.

The building is located in the downtown of Vladivostok.
